Key Bonspiel Rules

- Games are played based on the rules booklet on the United States Curling Association Website and posted at the welcome table. Any disputes should first be worked out by skips agreement. We will assign an impartial person to be the final arbitrator if necessary.
- Games should start at stated times. Clock is on the scoreboard. You have two hours to finish your eight end games with up to a fifteen minute grace period to complete a last end. A cowbell will ring after 1 hour and 55 minutes. Please do not begin a new ends after the cowbell. Any games ending in a tie will either:
 - Play a full end if less than two hours are up.
 - If two hours are up - Play a skips draw. Closest to the button with sweeping.
- At the end of your first draw on Friday night, each team will select one player to take a draw to the button. Sweeping is allowed. The distance for each draw (up to 18 feet) will be measured from the button and the results used to determine tie breakers for byes later on in the bracket.

Additional Bonspiel Events to Participate In

1. Raffle

This is where we offset the costs of beverages by offering “lavish” and “unique” prizes in our raffle and raise some money for our general fund. So please feel free to buy and buy often. Place tickets in the appropriate bag for each item you want. We will draw tickets at 7:55 pm Saturday and the winning ticket will be placed on the item for collection later. To date highlight raffle items include a Garmin Nuvi 1300, Oral B Sonic Toothbrush Kit, Wine, and a Comfort System Pump (instant hot water).

2. Draw to the 4 foot. (Friday Night)

On Friday night, during all three draws, there will be a box at the end of the rink behind the sheets. When you or a teammate draws to the 4-foot, grab the box and place it behind your sheet. If someone else from another team draws the 4-foot later on, they take the box away from you, etc. The team with the box when the bell sounds marking the end of the draw wins the prize.

3. Draw to the Button. (Saturday Afternoon)

Saturday Afternoon at 2:45 pm, we will have a 50/50 “Draw to the Button Contest”. We will use Sheets B, C, or D. The person who draws the closest to any of the button wins. 50% of the collected pot. Cost is \$3 for one delivery or \$5 for two deliveries. No sweeping is allowed, and no second delivery is allowed on the same sheet of ice or with the same stone. Registration deadline is 2:30pm Saturday at the welcome table.

4. Are you the Biggest Hogger?

Throughout the event, anyone who commits a hog line foul may voluntarily “donate” 50 cents into the hog bucket next to the hog line. You should then sign your name to a raffle ticket and we will draw a single name to determine the winner of a very special porky prize. Sweepers, feel free to hold your teammates rocks at ransom for at least 25 cents.

5. Opening Ceremony Parade Including Bagpipers – Friday at 8:15 PM

6. USCA Executive Discussion and Open House (Saturday TBD)

Four executive members from the United States Curling Association will be on hand to update recent USCA developments and take questions. This will occur in the warm room. Due to potential conflicts with the Bonspiel bracket, this time may be moved as a result of the USCA Executive Team’s progress through the bracket. Announcements will be made on Saturday.

7. Beverages

Free beverages are available to curlers and meal ticket holders through most of the event via our catered beverage service. All beverages should be consumed in plastic cups. Late night trips to local pubs may be organized after the last draw of the evening concludes.

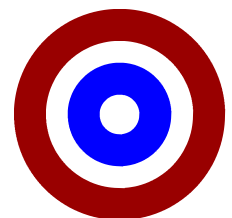
